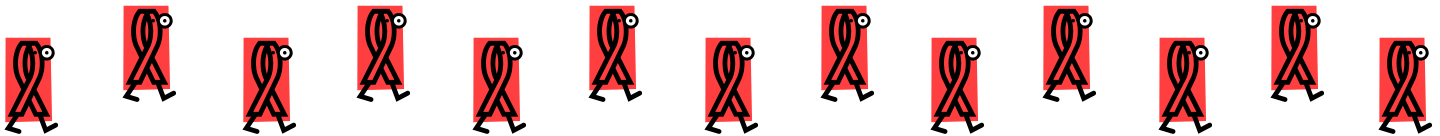


RED RIBBON WEEK
